○ **Business Award**

This Award is to be presented in recognition of a Huronia Community business that has demonstrated outstanding financial support and community involvement in philanthropic causes. Motivation of others to take leadership roles will also be recognized.

○ **Philanthropic Group Award**

This Award is to be presented in recognition of a Huronia Community Service Club, Religious Organization, Not-for-Profit Organization or Granting Foundation that has demonstrated outstanding commitment through financial support and through encouragement and motivation of others to take leadership roles toward local philanthropy.

○ **Individual Award**

This Award is to be presented in recognition of a Huronia Community individual philanthropist for his/her exceptional financial commitment to our community and their skills in coordinating and motivating groups of volunteers for fundraising projects for the benefit of local charitable causes.

○ **Youth or Youth Group Award**

This Award is to be presented in recognition of outstanding leadership in fundraising on the part of a Huronia Community youth (5 to 18 years of age) or a college or university student.
