FUNDS

OUR DONORS & THEIR STORIES

COMMUNITY UNRESTRICTED ENDOWMENT FUND

This is a general Fund that gives the Foundation the greatest flexibility in awarding Grants to charities. This type of Fund is not tied into any specific charity or area of interest, allowing the Foundation to respond to the immediate and changing needs of the community.

DESIGNATED ENDOWMENT FUND

This type of Fund gives the donor the opportunity to specify, at the time the Fund is established, which particular charity or charities they would like to support in perpetuity.

FLOW-THROUGH FUND

Flow-Through Funds are basically intended to come in and go out frequently. Flow-Through Funds are not eligible for our pooled Endowments Funds program and do not accumulate any interest. Funds could come from a fund-raising event or by donation.

DONOR ADVISED ENDOWMENT FUND

This Fund enables donors to have ongoing participation in the selection of charities that will benefit from their gift.

FIELD OF INTEREST ENDOWMENT FUND

Donors identify an area of interest that they would like their donation to support. Examples include the Arts, Environment, Health, Seniors, Children, Youth, Recreation, Relief of Poverty, or Education.

AGENCY FUNDS

The purpose of an Agency Fund is to support the charitable activities of a Fundholder that is a registered charity. Funds are held in perpetuity by the Foundation.

THE PETER ROBINSON MEMORIAL FUND

Peter Robinson was an active member of his community and well loved by all who knew him. He passed away in July 2016. Peter's wife Ailsa contacted the Foundation to help her carry on Peter's legacy by continuing to give back to his community annually through a donor advised fund. These are some of her words, shared at his celebration of life: "Yes, he was happy ALL THE TIME. Because he loved life, he loved his family and he loved all of you more than I can ever express in words. As you leave and go back to your lives can I say this to you: Remember Peter, remember his joy of life, remember how he lived every day to its absolute fullest. He shared laughter and happiness wherever he went. If everyone in the world lived just a little more like Peter... WOW! In the immortal words of Louis Armstrong, "What a wonderful world this would be."
