- Attend the fall annual general meeting
- Commit the time and resources to serve on the board
- Actively participate on two or more Board Committees

Terms begin at the fall annual general meeting, usually held in September, with a minimum commitment of one (1) year and eligibility for re-election for a 3 year term.
