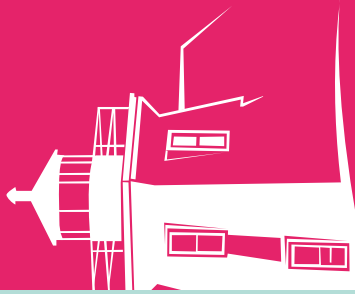

President's Message

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Huronian Community Foundation (HCF) is a charity for charities. We have 78 individual Funds created by caring citizens totalling over \$3.2 million in support of charities across Southern Georgian Bay.

Since 2001, HCF has stewarded more than \$3.5 million in gifts. This past year, HCF's investments achieved a 52% return. Grants totalling \$266,566 have been given to 66 charities dedicated to supporting our youth, protecting the environment and helping those in greatest need.

2018/19 has been a year of focus and achievements. Here are just a few of the gains we have made:

1. Get Better Known. HCF has increased our presence on social media and an improved website, new promotional materials, three public events and several community activities. Help us share our good work by signing up for our newsletter and following us on Facebook and Twitter.

2. Growth of Funds. This year HCF established five new funds. Several others have made significant gains led by YMCA Camp Kitchikewana. How big can we get? HCF is still relatively small. Other CFs serving similar populations hold \$16 million in philanthropic assets. We are determined to increase our impact in the coming year.

3. Infrastructure support. HCF has a 13 member working board of directors. All have outstanding qualifications, terrific energy and the dedication to support HCF's success. We are grateful to former Board Chair Barbara Jones who was acting ED for much of 2018. Stephen Couchman provided leadership for 2019. Unfortunately he will be leaving HCF at the end of September to take on a project overseas. In his place we are excited that Scott Warnock, former Mayor of Tay Township and active community volunteer, has agreed to lead HCF into the future.

It has been a year of growth and development thanks to the HCF board, staff, volunteers, community charities and of course, our very generous donors. Together we address local needs and make our community stronger. A sincere thank you to all of you.

ACHIEVEMENTS

In 2018/2019 Huronian Community Foundation has continued to contribute to a resilient, caring and sharing community. HCF stewarded \$266,566 in 128 grants to 66 charities and community organizations. Some of the many achievements are listed below:

- **Smart & Caring Grants Program** provided \$24,500 in support for local charities and community organizations.
- Arranged \$30,000 for local youth led initiatives through **RBC Future Launch Challenge** to be distributed in 2019/2020.
- Facilitated 8 post-secondary scholarships for students from **Beausoleil First Nation** valued at over \$6,000.

• Charitable partner helping to enable the activities of **Brookside Music Association**.

• Provided over \$20,000 in program and scholarship support for students from **GBDSS**.

• Establishment of a \$10,000 endowment and over \$5,000 in gifts to **Hospice Huronia** through Giving For A Cause event.

• Made the **Scientists in the Schools** program available for primary students in the region.

• Significant contributor to **Sistema Huronia** music program plus a donation of \$10,000 for the creation of an endowment fund.

• Worked with **YMCA** to establish an endowment fund for **Camp Kitchikewana's** 100th Anniversary.

• Provided critical support to **Wendat's** Supported Employment Program encouraging peer training and computer skills for 12 individuals.

• Contributed to **Georgian Bay General Hospital's** therapy garden.

• Purchased computer for **Severn Sound Environmental Association** used to track invasive species in the region.

• Facilitated charitable contributions to the **Southern Georgian Bay Family Physician Recruitment Program**.
