Vice President's Message VICE PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Another year of the COVID-19 pandemic and Huronia Community Foundation (HCF) has seen the impact that this "new normal" has had on our society. It is a testament to HCF's supporters, and the hard work of our Board of Directors and Executive Director, that HCF has continued to grow and have a positive impact in our community.

The 2020/2021 year saw HCF partner with Community Foundations of Canada and the Government of Canada to deliver the Government of Canada's Emergency Community Support Fund in the North Simcoe region, supporting populations experiencing heightened vulnerability as a result of COVID-19. HCF also created the HCF COVID-19 Community Response Fund to support the work of local community organizations at the forefront of assisting those most significantly impacted by the pandemic.

Financially we saw a reversal of the stock market freefall that negatively impacted our 2019/2020 year-end. By September 2020, our fund balances were back up to pre-Covid levels. The establishment of new endowment funds, through the generosity of local citizens and organizations enabled us to finish the year positively, with our assets under stewardship slightly over \$4 million.

In August 2020, HCF established a new partnership with Chigamik Community Health Centre and graciously accepted an offer of office space within the Chigamik Community Health Hub. We thank them for their continued support. HCF also extends a very special mention to Barbara Jones for providing us with our previous home.

2020/2021 was a year that saw HCF make great strides in locally promoting the benefits that the Foundation provides. We have leveraged social media to help spread the news of who we are and the great work that we are doing; we've connected with our local media outlets to extend our reach beyond those online, we have engaged with charities across our region to promote the benefits of creating endowment funds and we have increased our presence with our donors and fund holders to ensure that we are getting it right.

In summary, I firmly believe that HCF is on a solid footing to continue the great work that our dedicated board members and staff have accomplished over the last year and on behalf of the Executive, I would like to thank them, our community volunteers, our local charities and especially our donors, to which all contributed to help make Huronia Community Foundation what it is today!

Achievements ACHIEVEMENTS

This past year, each and everyone of us faced the personal challenges of life in a global pandemic. COVID-19 highlighted the needs of our most vulnerable residents and locally charities and organizations were called on to do more with less, as they struggled to maintain their core services. As it has for over 20 years HCF and its fund holders played a key role in providing much needed financial support.

HCF stewarded **\$272,110.29** in 83 grants to 55 charities and community organizations. Some of the many achievements are listed below:

- **9 local charities** shared in \$11,000 from the **HCF COVID-19 Community Response Fund**.

- The **Emergency Community Support Fund**, a collaboration between the **Federal Government**, **Community Foundations of Canada** and **HCF** provided financial support to **43** recipients totalling **\$134,500**.

- **5 local youth-led initiatives** were successfully completed in 2020 as part of the **RBC Future Launch Community Challenge**

- **HCF** facilitated two successful **Vital Conversations with Youth** in collaboration with the Township of Tiny and the YMCA Simcoe/Muskoka as part of the **RBC Future Launch Community Challenge**.

- The establishment of new agency endowment funds with **Wendat Community Programs**, **Catholic Family Services of Simcoe County** and **Chigamik Community Health Centre**.

- Facilitated post-secondary scholarships for students from **Beausoleil First Nation** valued at \$6,000 including the establishment of the **Naadaamadewin Flow Through Fund**.

- **LabX Media Group** through the Huronia Community Foundation provided **14** grants totalling \$14,000 to local charities and organizations.

- The establishment of **3** new donor advised Endowment Funds. The **Jones Family Endowment Fund**, the **Bimbombay Memorial Fund** and the **Harold and Audrey Curry Endowment Fund**.

- Scientists in School provided **56 complimentary virtual classroom workshops** in local elementary schools through the financial support of **LabX Media Group**.

- The **COVID-19 Community Response Fund** was the recipient of a \$2,000 donation from the Annual Tiny Township Mayor's Golf Tournament. Township Mayor's Golf Tournament.
